

Membership Management

1. Introduction

According to the statutes of Hepatitis Switzerland, natural and legal persons with an interest in viral hepatitis can apply for membership of Swiss Hepatitis. It is up to the Board of Swiss Hepatitis to decide on the admission of new members and to determine the amount for the membership fees. This document regulates the membership categories and the administration of the members of Swiss Hepatitis. It enters into force upon adoption by the Board and is valid until revoked.

2. Member categories

2.1. Members of the network Swiss Hepatitis Strategy

The members of the Swiss Hepatitis Strategy Network do their work in the network free of charge. At the general meeting 2018 of Swiss Hepatitis it was decided to accept the network members as members of the association Swiss Hepatitis. New network members will be informed about the automatic membership in Swiss Hepatitis. A resignation from the association is of course possible. A written notification to the office of Swiss Hepatitis is sufficient. The drug manufacturing industry is excluded from automatic membership. Network members are exempt from paying a membership fee.

2.2. Other members

Natural and legal persons who are not members of the Swiss Hepatitis Strategy Network pay a membership fee.

It amounts to:

for natural persons CHF 20/year

for legal entities CHF 100/year

The invoices are sent out at the beginning of each year.

3. Services

The services provided by Swiss Hepatitis include, on the one hand, working towards the common goal of eliminating viral hepatitis in Switzerland. Swiss Hepatitis informs its members about new findings and developments in the field of viral hepatitis. For this purpose, an e-newsletter is sent to the members.

For members who are members of the Network Swiss Hepatitis Strategy, this is done via the Network News. It informs every 2-3 months about the work of Swiss Hepatitis and the Swiss Hepatitis Strategy.

Members who are not network members receive the Swiss Hepatitis News, which is based on the Network News, but does not contain network-specific information and invitations.

The invitation to the annual meeting is regulated in the statutes.
